Teams All teams will play each other 1 time. With 1<sup>st</sup> place and 2<sup>nd</sup> place trophy . The highest finishing Industrial team, and the highest finishing church team will represent Gainesville in District tournament. If any ties exist then head to head competition will be used to break the tie. If 3 or more teams are tied we will add points scored against points allowed between tied teams higher point spread will be placed higher in standings

Teams please have your lineups ready 10 minutes prior top scheduled game time. Game time is forfeit time no exceptions. If two teams have same color jerseys then we will flip a coin and winning team has option to wear pullovers or have other team wear them.

After the first week teams must have matching shirts with legal basketball number on them. If a player does not have a legal high school basketball number he will be asset a technical foul that will also be counted toward his personal foul totals, but will be able to play in local league only. This is in all games that he participates in. Example: if a team has 3 illegal numbers the other team would shoot 6 technical free throws before the game. Illegal numbers will not be allowed at GRPA District tournaments.
