

# 21 DAYS OF PRAYER

AUGUST 9-29, 2020

**D**o you know what God says about you if you are in Christ? Do you know your identity? What have you been placing your identity in? For 21 days of prayer from August 9-29 we will be focusing on understanding those Truths, living them out, and then serving others out of that identity.

**8/9 Proverbs 3:19-26** speaks of resting securely because the Lord is my confidence. What have I been putting my security in besides the Lord?

**8/10** Because I am secure in Christ I don't have to be afraid today of the unstable world around me. How can you focus on your security in Jesus today?

**8/11** Because I am secure in Christ I can love others with confidence regardless of their response. Who is God asking you to show love to today in a tangible way and what is your plan to do that?

**8/12 2 Timothy 1:7** says we have been given in Christ a spirit of power, love, and a sound mind. Are you operating out of those three things?

**8/13** Because we are secure in Christ we have the ability to live from what He gives us and not operate out of our fear feelings all the time. How can you choose faith over feelings today?

**8/14** Because you have a sound mind and love in Christ, how can you show someone grace today that may not know those Truths?

**8/15 Philippians 1:6** says we can be confident that He who began a good work in us through Jesus will complete what He began. Are you allowing Him to work out of you the things that are not of Him and to work into you what He desires?

**8/16** Because I am secure in Christ, I can be confident in His work in me, not my self-sufficiency. What areas are you walking in self-sufficiency vs. confidence in Jesus?

**8/17** Because I am secure in Christ, I can encourage someone else in their walk of confidence in Jesus without envy or pride. Whom do you need to encourage today?

**8/18** We are significant in Christ. **John 15:16** says He chose you and appointed you to go and bear lasting fruit. Thank Him for giving you significance in Him in this world.

**8/19** Because we are significant in Christ, we can walk by the Spirit in us and bear lasting fruit for His glory. What kind of fruit is being produced in your life right now? Is it fruit that has eternal value?

**8/20** Because we know our significance is from Christ, we are free to build up the body of Christ and help those around us. How can you use your freedom in Christ to build up another person today?

**8/21 Ephesians 2:10** says we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to walk in. You are significant because He designed you to do what He has planned for your life. Are you walking out that plan or your own plan?

**8/22** Because I am significant in Christ I can let go of trying to control all my circumstances and others and rest confidently that He has plans for me and will equip me to carry out those plans.

**8/23** Because I am significant in Christ I can treat others with kindness and respect, and love as He commanded me to love. Who is He asking you to show kindness to today?

**8/24** In Christ I am accepted. **Romans 15:7** Accept one another, then, just as Christ has accepted you, in order to bring praise to God. We all want to feel accepted. Choose to believe this Truth today that in Christ you are accepted by Him even if your feelings tell you otherwise. Truth is still Truth whether you feel like it or not.

**8/25** Because I am accepted in Christ I don't have to look for my acceptance in all the wrong places, people or things. Where have you been finding your acceptance lately?

**8/26** Because I am accepted in Christ I can accept others and try to love them where they are. **Ephesians 4:15** says we are to speak the Truth in love and grow up in all aspects into Christ. We can speak Truth of Scripture from a heart and mind of love. How can you do that today?

**8/27** In Christ I have direct access to God through the Holy Spirit. I am so grateful that the Holy Spirit is my helper and counselor. Thank God today that He did not leave us here alone and without help of doing what He put us here to do.

**8/28** Because I am accepted in Christ and have the Holy Spirit I can choose to listen to Him daily and recognize my old patterns that lead to problems and walk in a new way. In what area do you need to listen to the Holy Spirit today?

**8/29** Because I am accepted in Christ and have the Holy Spirit I can listen to His prompts for me to help someone else today, to use the comfort I have received to comfort someone else. Is the Holy Spirit putting someone on your mind today to reach out to?
