

WHAT IS THE ROMANS ROAD?

Romans Road lays out God's plan of salvation through a series of Bible verses from the book of Romans. When arranged in order, these verses form an easy, systematic way of understanding and explaining the message of salvation. In 2024, together as a church, we will memorize these verses from the ESV.

Romans Road clearly defines:

1. Who needs salvation. (January)

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." - **Romans 3:23**

2. Why we need salvation. (February)

"For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." - **Romans 6:23**

3. How God provides salvation. (March)

"But God shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." - **Romans 5:8**

4. How we receive salvation.

*"because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. **10** For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved."* - **Romans 10:9-10** (April/May)

For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." - **Romans 10:13** (June)

5. The results of salvation.

"Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." - **Romans 5:1** (July)

"There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus." - **Romans 8:1** (August)

*“For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, **39** nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.” - Romans 8:38-39* (September/October)

November and December will be used for review to better ensure long-term remembrance.
