NOTE FROM

Dr. Tyler Smiley

A new year gives us a chance to reflect on all God has done in the previous year and to look ahead with expectation to what the Lord will do in the year to come. As a church family, we step into 2026 with gratitude for His faithfulness to us and with a renewed desire to follow Jesus faithfully in the days ahead.

In the coming months, we will spend Sunday mornings in the Gospel of John. John's gospel takes us right to the center of the identity of Jesus, considering His life, teaching, death, and resurrection. And as John writes, his aim in writing about Jesus is "so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name" (John 20:31). I pray the Lord accomplishes that goal in our lives this year.

As we consider how to walk faithfully this year, here are two simple practices that can help you grow in your relationship with Christ:

- Make a habit of reading your Bible daily. If you don't already have a reading plan for the year, this is a great moment to begin one. You can also receive our daily Bible reading texts, which correspond with sermon passages and help create a steady rhythm in the Word. (See page 4.)
- Stay close to the people who help you follow Jesus. Small groups, Bible studies, and Wednesday night gatherings give us places to ask questions, grow together, and share life in meaningful ways. You'll find several opportunities on page 6.
