



We are so excited that you have signed up to be part of the **LEAD TEAM** option at Summer Camp this July! Below are a few dates and details you need to know so please look this over, discuss it with your parents and let us know if you have any questions. CAMP DATES: Tuesday July 9 (**this is 1 day earlier than other students**) – Sunday July 14

LOCATION: Covenant College (14049 Scenic Highway Lookout Mountain, GA 30750). This camp (Generate Camp) is hosted by YM360: generatestudents.com.

TRAVEL DETAILS: We will meet up at Lakewood in The Lodge at **2:45 p.m. sharp on Tuesday July 9** to load up and depart for camp. We'll be taking a Lakewood van and our plan is to arrive around 6:00 and eat dinner in town (bring some money for this) before heading to Covenant College. For our return trip, we will leave camp the morning of **Sunday July 14 and return to Lakewood by 12:00** (same time the Real Life worship service lets out).

BALANCE AND DEADLINES: The total cost for this **LEAD TEAM** camp option is \$150 (including the \$75 deposit). We mailed you a letter over month ago with the total amount you still owe but if you have questions about this, please contact Jessica Hart in our Student Ministry office (jhart@lakewoodlife.org or 770-532-6307). You can pay this balance anytime on our camp website (lakewoodlife.org/summercamp) or in The Lodge but this is due **no later than Sunday June 23**.

WAIVERS AND RELEASE FORMS: Everyone attending Summer Camp needs to turn in two important forms: a current Lakewood Student Ministry Release Form AND a YM360 Waiver/Release Form. The YM360 form that we mailed to you must be notarized (both Jessica in our student ministry office and Nancy in the front office at church are notaries). Many of you already have a Lakewood Release Form on file from previous events this year but you can check with Jessica in our student ministry office if you're not sure. These forms are available in The Lodge but may also be downloaded from lakewoodlife.org/summercamp. Please turn these forms in to our student ministry office as soon as possible but **no later than Sunday June 23**. You must have both of these forms to attend Summer Camp.

TALENT SHOW: There will be a camp-wide Talent Show on Night 2 of camp called "The Get Down." Each year at The Get Down, everyone is encouraged to wear clothes that match the theme for the night. This summer, the theme for The Get Down is the 80s! You can bring some clothes for this if you want.

PRE-CAMP PREPARATIONS

1. Pray: Ask that during this time we have together, the Lord will help put some new tools in your toolbox as you grow as a leader and servant, but ultimately, as a follower of Christ.
2. Assessments: You may have taken a personality and/or spiritual gifts test before. Either way, we would like for you to take these two **BEFORE** coming to GENERATE:

PARTICIPATING AT CAMP

When we are together at camp, we will have a few connection points that will allow you to not only grow through learning but also doing. Here are just a few of the things we will be involved in together:

1. Serve churches, in ways both seen and unseen.
2. Pray for participants.
3. Participate in various staff meetings, devotions and prayer times.
4. Serve alongside the GENERATE Summer Staff.
5. Discuss what Leadership is and talk through Traits of a Leader.
6. Be assigned a mentor from the GENERATE team for the week.
7. Review test results and talk about how those help us as a leader, servant and Christ-follower.
8. Grow as a group.
9. Fellowship with our team and experience a week of what it is like to serve on a camp staff.

PROCESSING AT HOME:

Our hope is that as you leave your week at GENERATE, you will continue to process the things you've learned and experienced. We pray that applying the Great Commission to your daily life would become a natural part of your already established routines at home and in the local church.

PACKING LIST

- Bring your Bible! Part of serving with our staff means attending staff daily devotions
- Proper clothing for 5 days (see dress code)
- Towels and washcloths
- Needed toiletries and medications
- Closed-toe shoes and shower shoes
- Work gloves
- Each person will receive a LEAD Team t-shirt that they will be asked to wear every day (we will wash them there each night)
- It is important for us to be on time, so a watch is suggested (maybe an alarm clock too!)
- Bring a reusable water bottle so you can stay hydrated!
- Please bring sunscreen, too!
- Bring a pillow and linens or a sleeping bag for a twin sized bed
- Trust us, you'll want to bring some snacks.
- Spending money for snacks and souvenirs
- Bathing suit (see dress code)
- Lastly, bring a great attitude that's ready to serve and be challenged!

LAKESWOOD POLICIES

- As you are part of our LEAD TEAM, some of our normal Lakewood policies will work different for you this year (compared the rest of our Lakewood students) because of the nature of your role at camp. This requires more trust on our part but also more responsibility on your part so please keep this in mind and don't abuse it.
- As for your cell phone, please bring one as we will be spread out different places around campus and need to stay in communication with one another. During the week, your phone is primarily to be used for staying connected with each other and YM360 staff and for checking in with your parents (not for social media, gaming, YouTube, texting friends back home, etc.). The only time we will collect your phone is before bed at night.
- As for medication, you are welcome to hang on to any of your own prescription medication (unless your parents want us to manage this). However, we need to have a record of any prescription medication on file in case you have a medical issue. Please see the attached medical card and bring this filled-out on the day we leave.
- Everyone is expected to have a great attitude and to live out the highest standards of Christian conduct at all times during this week of camp. Remember, you represent Jesus Christ, your family and Lakewood.
- Don't bring any of the following: drugs, alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, weapons of any kind, clothing with alcoholic or vulgar images/slogans, gaming consoles (PS4, XBOX, etc.).
- All students are expected to attend everything on the schedule and to be on time.
- No PDA (public displays of affection).
- No guys allowed in girls' rooms and no girls allowed in guys' rooms.
- Be aware that you are responsible for any damages to your room.

DRESS CODE

FROM YM360

As an extension of our staff, and a representation of YM360, we want to do whatever it takes to present ourselves in a respectful way and not be a distraction to the Gospel. Our staff holds the responsibility to make sure themselves and others uphold this standard. If an attendee (LEAD Team member is dressed inappropriately, our staff may ask them to go change.

- DAY 1: Registration Day - LEAD Team t-shirt, khaki style shorts* or pants, tennis shoes.
- DAY 2 – DAY 4 (Daytime): LEAD Team t-shirt, athletic shorts*, tennis shoes (structured shoe. NO Toms, slip-ons) or sandals with back (Teva, Chaco, Keen, etc.). Please refrain from wearing shorts that are tight and/or shorter than fingertip length.
- Every Evening: In the evenings, like our staff, we ask that our LEAD Team come to worship clean and dressed in casual church attire. For girls, this means NO tank tops without a cardigan, bra straps showing, crop tops, shorts, or rips in jeans above the knee. For guys, this means NO tanks, athletic shorts or low-riding pants.

LAKESWOOD DRESS CODE FOR GUYS

- Please make sure all attire is modest and appropriate.
- No speedos or anything that semi-resembles a speedo.
- Unless you're at the pool, wear a shirt at all times that completely covers the chest/torso.
- No sagging of shorts, pants or swim trunks.

LAKESWOOD DRESS CODE FOR GIRLS

- Please make sure all attire is modest and appropriate.
- One piece bathing suits (no cutouts) OR tankini's that fully cover the stomach are fine. Tankini tops must remain down at all times, if not you will be asked to put on a cover up. Straps are required!
- Stomach should be covered at all times.
- All shirts and dresses should have a modest neckline.
- No halter/tube/spaghetti strap tops. Tank tops that are at least 3 fingers wide can be worn during the day but not to evening worship. No oversized tank tops that show your sides.
- No Demin shorts or other "short" shorts or skirts. Skirts and dresses should keep you fully covered when bending over. If you have any questions about this, you may talk with one of our female leaders.
