Three Examples of Patience

A. The _____: Patience in Problems.

*Be patient, therefore, brothers, until the coming of the Lord. See how the
farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, being patient about it,
until it receives the early and the late rains. You also, be patient.*

James 5:7-8a ESV

Patience Begins With _____:

*Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that
you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it
is working. Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed
fervently that it might not rain, and for three years and six months it did
not rain on the earth. Then he prayed again, and heaven gave rain, and
the earth bore its fruit.*
