



During this 21 days of prayer, we will focus on passages from the book of James. We will pray through these verses together and learn more about our call to walk worthy in the Lord. As we continue to focus on Truth this year we will read about how we are called to live in this world as His people. Read through each passage daily and then pray through each verse according to how the Spirit convicts or reminds you to walk.

8/7 James 1:3,4 Steadfastness is a quality we need now. Pray for steadfastness to stay the course of faith.

8/8 James 1: 5-8 Ask God today for wisdom and then do only what God says.

8/9 James 1:13-15 Know what your temptations are. Become aware of how to recognize them before you fall into them again.

8/10 James 1:17 Every good and perfect gift is from the Father. Thank Him today for all the gifts He has given you.

8/11 James 1:19, 20 Be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger today. The anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

8/12 James 1:21 Receive with humility the implanted word - the Word of God that has been sown into you. Humbly receive and walk in it.

8/13 James 1:22-25 What part of the Word have you heard but are not doing?

8/14 James 1:26,27 How do you need to bridle your tongue today? How can you keep yourself unstained by the world today?

8/15 James 2:1-13 Have you been showing partiality or judging those around you? Mercy triumphs over judgement.

8/16 James 2:18-26 Faith without works is dead. Faith is best displayed in obedience. How can you show your faith in obedience today?

8/17 James 3: 1-12 As believers we should be speaking what is in line with the Word. Have your words lately been staining your whole body?

8/18 James 3:13-15 We cannot say we are wise and then act out of selfish ambition and in bitter jealousy. That is not true wisdom or understanding.

8/19 James 3:16-18 Wisdom from above looks very different than earthly knowledge. Filter the wisdom you receive through the lens of James 3:17.

8/20 James 4:6, 7 Submit yourself to God, resist the devil and he will flee. Submit first. Submission requires humility.

8/21 James 4:11-12 Have you been speaking against or judging those around you? Who are we to judge when God is the only righteous judge?

8/22 James 4:13-17 We should remember that all our days are in God's hands. If we know the right thing to do we should obey to honor the Lord.

8/23 James 5: 7,8 Let us be patient as we wait for all the Lord is doing and going to do. We must walk with perseverance in our faith journey.

8/24 James 5:9 Grumbling means to complain about something in a bad way. Have you been grumbling about another person? The Spirit wants to help us daily with the things that only He may see that do not honor God.

8/25 James 5:11 Be steadfast. This is another reminder to keep moving forward with the Lord just as Job did. Job grieved in the right ways and did ask questions, but he also sought out God's wisdom. He was steadfast.

8/26 James 5:12 Let your yes be yes and your no be no. Let your mouth speak truth and watch what you allow from your mouth.

8/27 James 5:13-18 There are several types of prayers found in these verses. Petitioning, interceding, and confessing. Prayer is vital to our spiritual growth. Continue practicing in prayer daily and see how the Spirit will grow you in your faith walk.
